The Bharateeya Santa Mahaa Parishhad has one objective, two action plans, and a seven-phase implementation method.

The Sole Objective of the Bharateeya Santa Mahaa Parishhad (BSMP)

'Bharateeya Sanskruti' is a Sanskruti that originated and evolved in our sacred land of Bharat. "All those who have the mother root of their tradition and main devotional center of their belief in this sacred land of Bharat, undoubtedly belong to the Bharateeya Sanskruti". This Sanskruti always preaches unity in diversity to the world, just as it is said, "Ekam Sat – Jnaaninah Bahudhaa Vadanti", which means "Truth is one, paths are many". Bharateeya Sanskruti is the only Sanskruti in the entire world that naturally and completely accepts diversity and pluralism. Therefore, Bharateeya Sanskruti is the fundamental basis for world peace, global harmony, and universal brotherhood.

As stated clearly by our ancient sages thousands

of years ago, the nine philosophical systems – 'Nava darshanas' belonging to 'Bharateeya Sanskriti' are Samkhya, Yoga, Nyaya, Vaisheshika, Purvamimamsa, Vedanta, Bauddha, Jaina, and Charvaka.

Within our highly diverse Bharateeya Sanskriti, there are great traditions like Shaiva, Shakta, Vaidika, Vaishnava, Agama, Veerashaiva – Lingayat, Jaina, Bouddha, Sikh, and others. The 'Bharateeya Sanskriti' is Bharateeya Sanskriti holds a maternal position for all these great traditions.

The Prabhodhaka shares the official website link with people and encourages them to spend at least 30 minutes every day engaging with the content related to Bharateeya Sanskruti. The Prabhodhaka motivates them to share the link widely among friends, family and social circles thereby help spread awareness and deepen the understanding of Bharateeya Sanskruti.

Sandhya Prarthana: Prayer to 'Ista Devata' in the morning and evening.

Swadhyaya: Reading good literature/scriptures.

Sadachara: Leading a value-based life by following the righteous path shown by parents, Gurus, and elders.

Samajikya: Performing altruistic acts with a spirit of equality and oneness.

Sahayoga: The collective effort to protect nature and living beings.

These are the five Common Samskaras (Uniform Ritual Code – URC).

ii) The Uniform Ritual Code (URC) applies very equally to every person belonging to Bharateeya Sanskruti.

iii) The Uniform Ritual Code does not involve imposing any particular belief on another person by force.

iv) Every person belonging to Bharateeya Sanskruti has the freedom to follow the Uniform Ritual Code according to their respective traditions.

v) Adhering to the 'Uniform Ritual Code' further strengthens the belief and devotion towards their respective tradition of every individual belonging to the Bharateeya Sanskruti.

vi) If the Uniform Ritual Code is followed with earnestness, no one belonging to Bharateeya Sanskruti will suffer the slightest loss. However, following this Uniform Ritual Code brings immense personal and collective benefits to every person belonging to Bharateeya Sanskruti.

2. Uniform General Samskara Education (UGSE)

1) Uniform General Samskara Education (UGSE) is the Bharateeya Sanskruti education (BSE) provided on a common platform for a period of eight years to all our

children aged six and above who belong to Bharateeya

Sanskrit.

In the Uniform General Samskara Education (UGSE), topics that are acceptable to all will be selected from the spiritual, religious, historical, cultural, literary, and scientific matters of **Bharateeya Sanskrit** within a framework of collective well-being and a harmonious perspective. These will be taught to our children in a highly systematic manner on a strong foundation of spirituality with scientific thinking. !!!) The Uniform General Samskara Education will be systematically taught to our children at the regional level through **General Samskara Centres (GSC)** to support and strengthen nationalism.
